

#### Dr Mel McKendrick from Heriot-Watt University explains:

"Digital transformation has been heralded as one of the greatest achievements of recent times but as psychologists, clinicians, parents and individuals, we're still exploring its impact. This study will examine stress from digitalisation, looking at it from the user's perspective to better understand changes in mental state, treatment and self-management. It is difficult for clinicians to monitor fluctuations in mental health and therefore accurately diagnose conditions in some cases. Meanwhile, services are at breaking point. We want to create innovative methods using gamification to better inform ways to support young people living in Scotland initially before helping to shape wider work across the UK."
